Regulations and Exemptions

A global variance is granted to modify 35.A.2 (Center Regulations) and modify 56.A and 70.A (Family and Large Family Child Care Homes Regulations)

To prevent the possible spread of COVID-19, the requirement for a "hands-on CPR skill demonstration" is temporarily suspended and is not required when CPR certification or recertification is due. This means that initial and expiring CPR certifications must be renewed as needed but the hands-on skill demonstration is not required at this time. CPR may be taken online, for example, without a hands-on skills demonstration and will be accepted as meeting the OCCL regulation until further guidance from OCCL is sent to child care providers. Certifications completed online during this period will be valid until the expiration date listed on the certification. If the certification of a child care provider or staff member has expired, he or she is required to be certified within one month of the certificate's expiration.

Reminder: Child care providers shall *recommend* mask use by children ages 2 through pre-kindergarten. Child care providers shall *require* mask use by children in kindergarten through twelfth grade, plus all staff, family members, and visitors inside the child care facility, regardless of vaccination status.

The Office of Child Care Licensing is now offering, "Health and Safety Training for Child Care Professionals." This seven-hour quality-assured training is designed for family and large family child care homes as well as child care centers. It covers emergency preparedness including disaster and evacuation plans; safe sleep procedures including prevention of sudden infant death syndrome, shaken baby syndrome, and abusive head trauma; prevention and response to emergencies due to food allergies; building and physical premises safety; handling and storage of hazardous materials; proper disposal of bio-contaminants; administration of medication, prevention and control of infectious diseases including immunizations, and how to transport children safely. This training may be used to meet many of the orientation topic requirements or to count toward annual health and safety training requirements.
