- Captures changes across time
- Data collected mainly from states' policy manuals

CCDF Policies Database Process

Collect Materials

- State policy manuals
- Manual updates issued by states
- Biennial CCDF Plans and amendments to Plans

Code Materials

- Policy manuals
- Policy updates
- Select CCDF Plan information

Prepare Tables

- Selected policies from the database
- Policies in effect on October 1st of each year

Verify Data

- Provide draft tables to states
- Work with state staff to verify data

Release Data

- Yearly Book of Tables
- Data files







Age Requirements for Most Children October 1, 2009








Eligible Activities: Education and Training October 1, 2009



Treatment of Family Members' Earnings October 1, 2009




Treatment of Different Types of Income and Benefits October 1, 2009




Deduction for Child Support Paid


Initial Eligibility Thresholds for a Three Person Family October 1, 2009
















